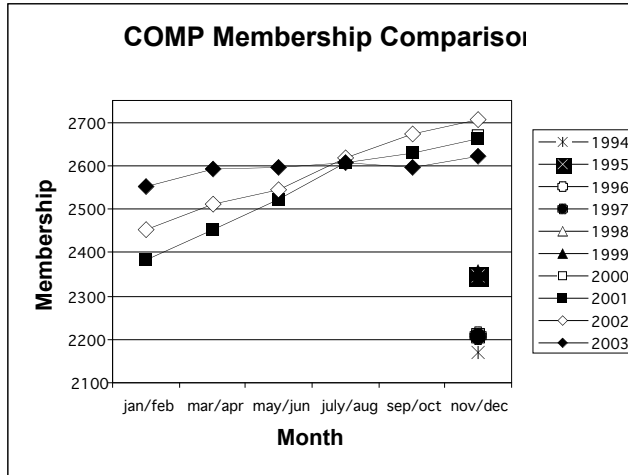

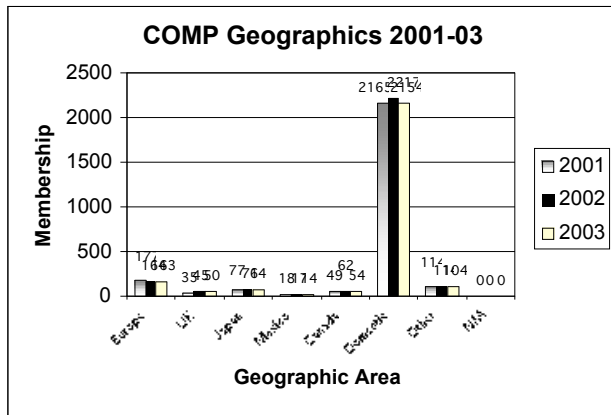
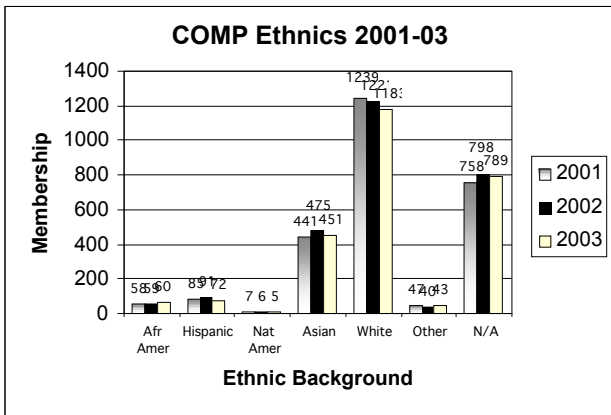
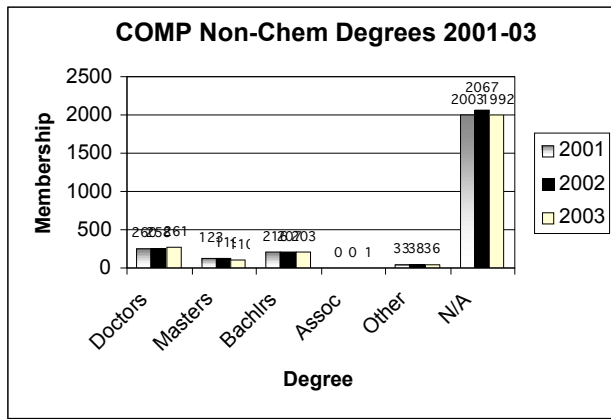
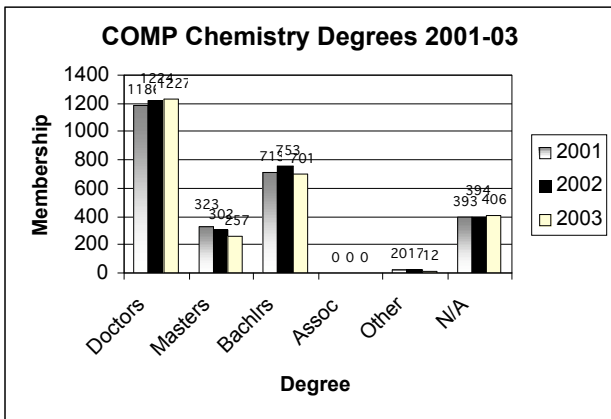
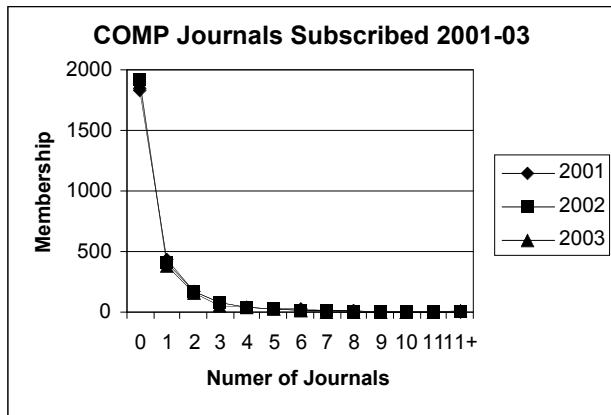
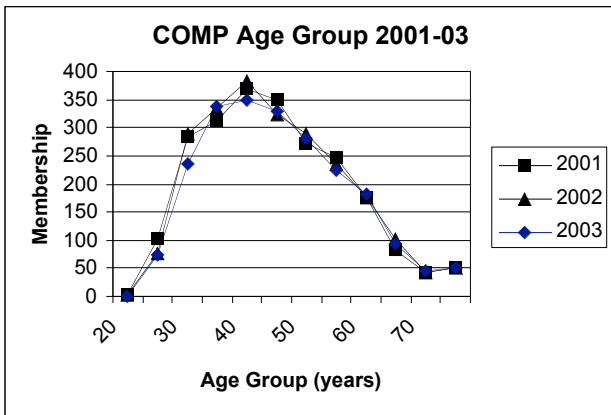
Two age groups (Table 1) have declined dramatically from 2002-03: 25-30 (-53 members) and 35-40 (-36 members).

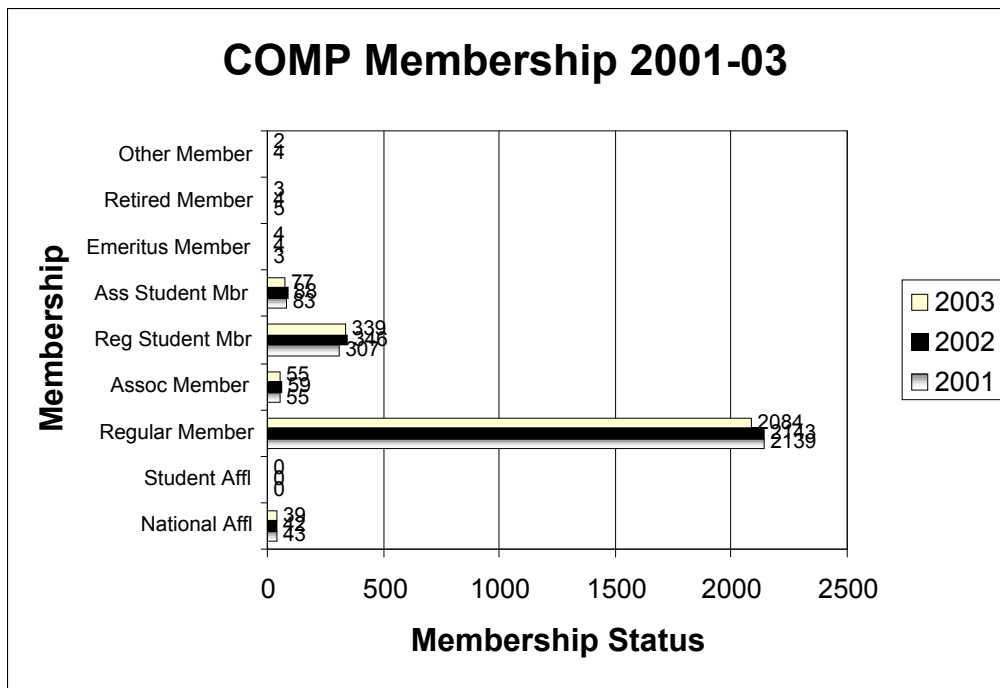
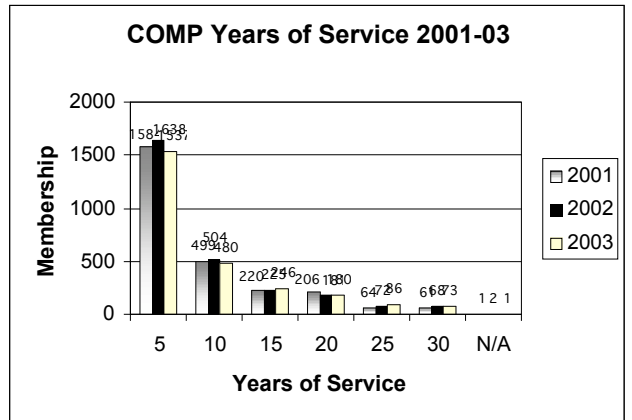
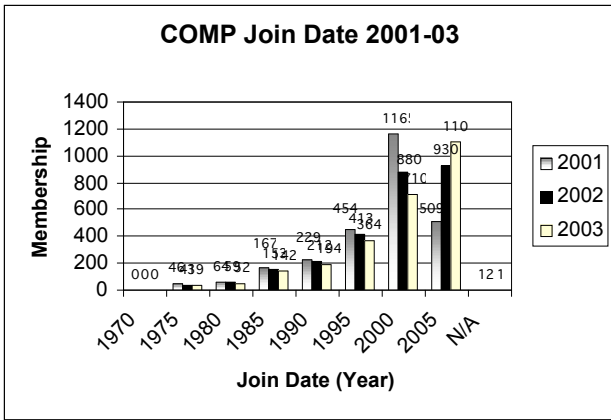
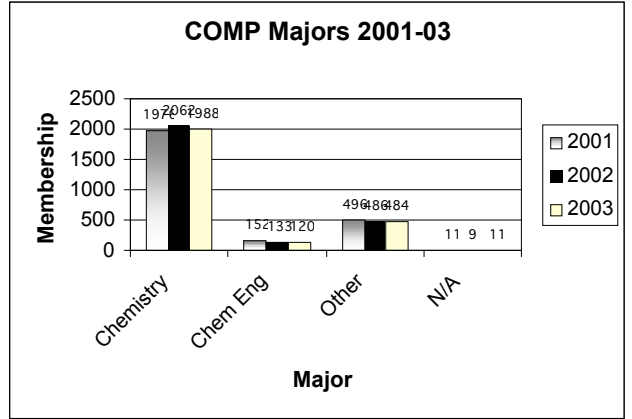
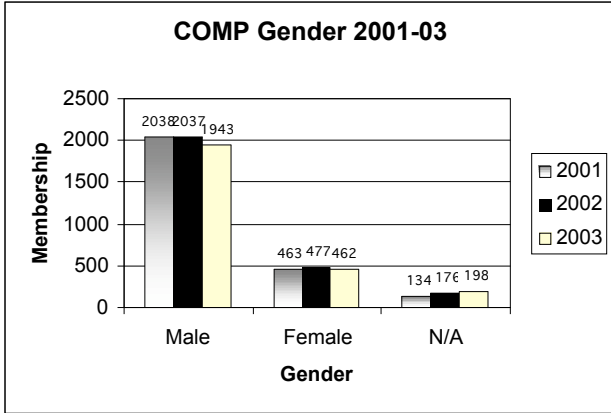

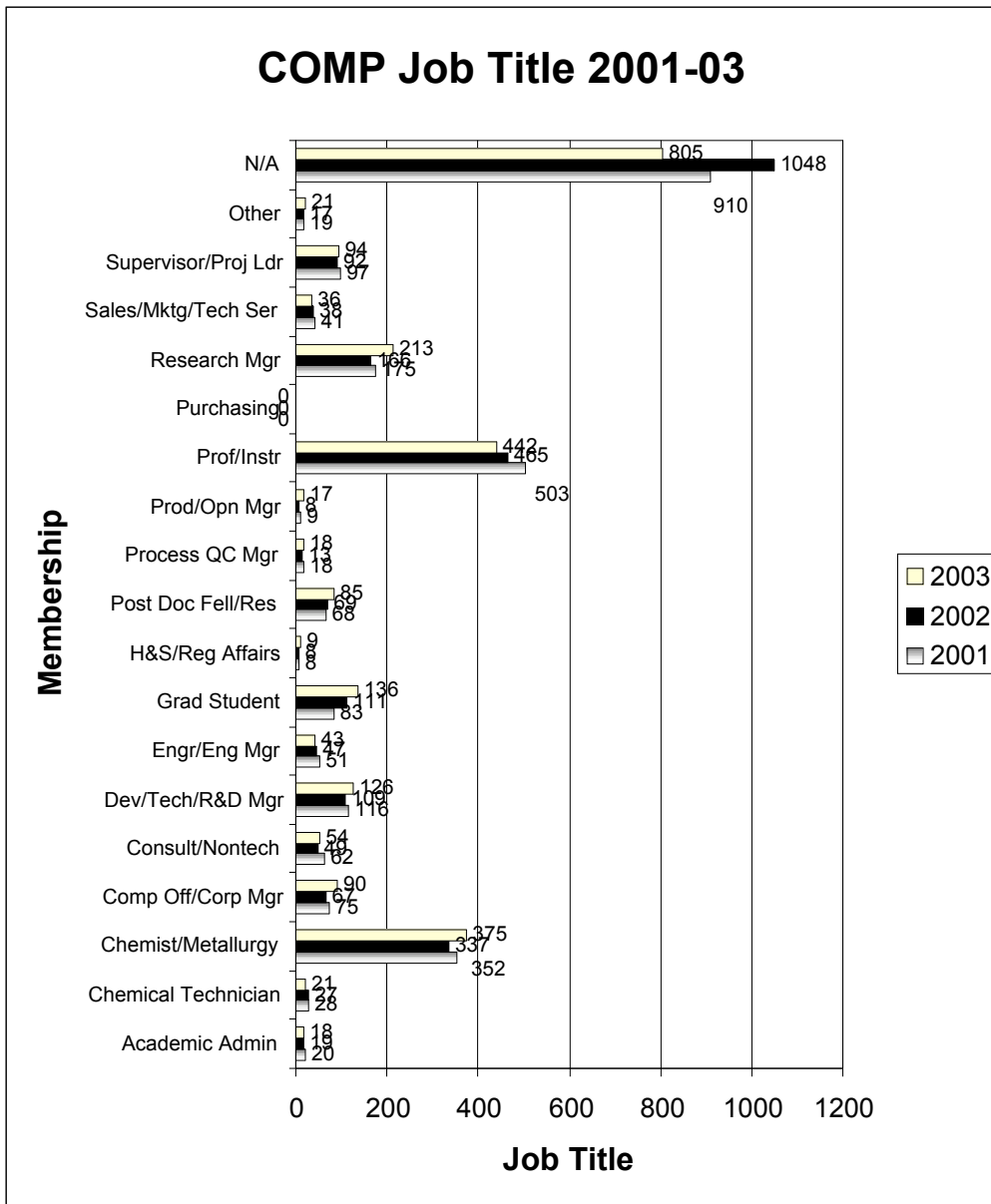




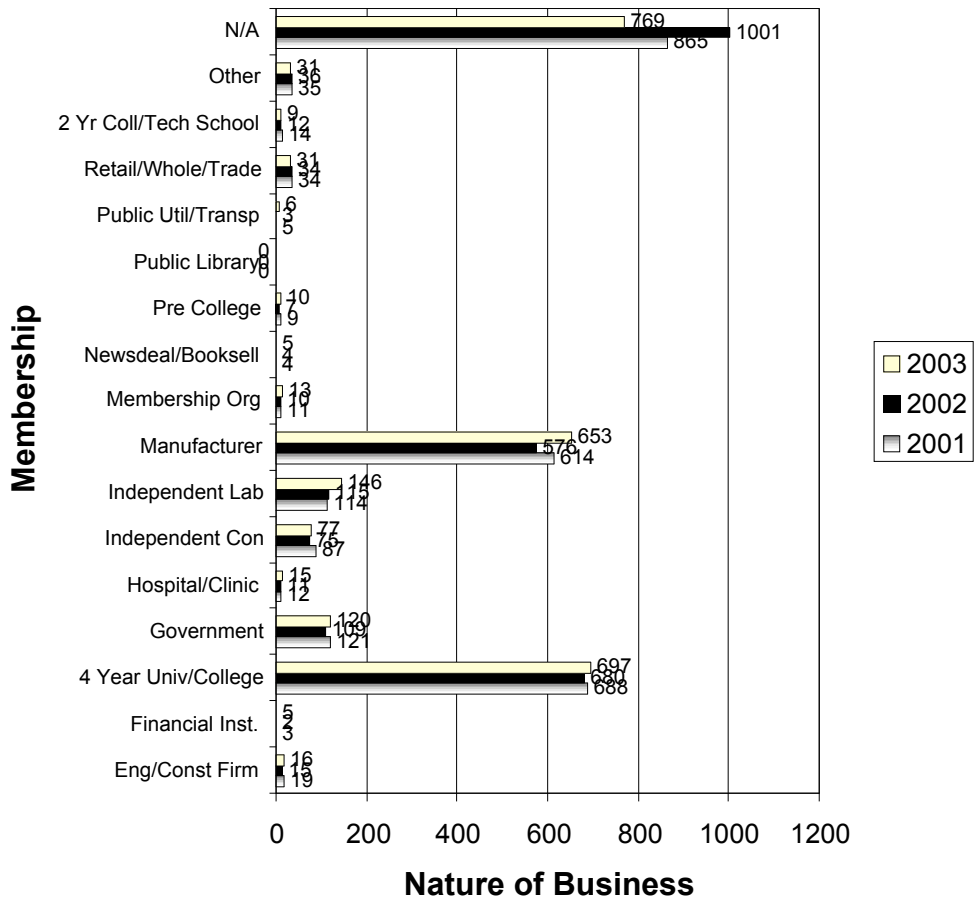
COMP Interest Field 2001-03
